Continuing with your DofE gives you the chance to discover just how much you're capable of. It's also a great way to meet new people, try new things, do what you love and make a difference in your community. Through the DofE, you could try everything from surfing to salsa dancing, coding to candle making, bee keeping to BMXing. It's your call.

DofE is non-competitive and for everyone – whatever your interests, background and abilities. It's about finding the confidence to be yourself, and knowing that when things get tough, you can find a way through.

How it works

The Silver Award is about progression from your Bronze Award. So you will participate in your sections for longer and they should be more challenging that those that you participated in at Bronze.

To achieve your Award, you'll need to complete four sections – Volunteering, Physical, Skills and the Expedition. What you do for the first three sections is up to you, and we'll give you all the support you need. The Expedition involves spending three days and two nights in the countryside, and again we'll make sure you're fully prepared for it.
