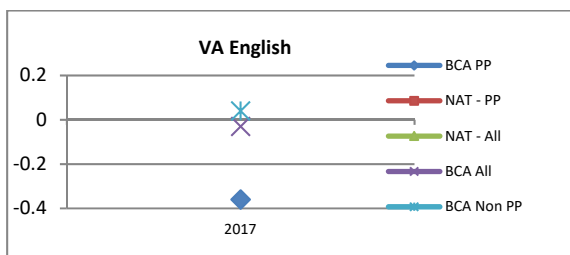
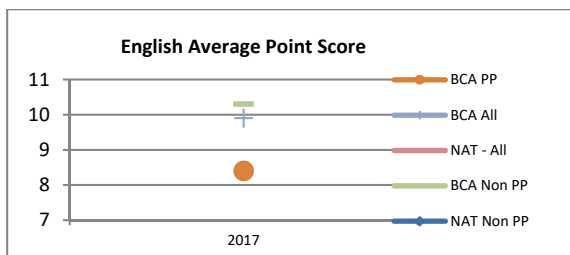


PUPIL PREMIUM GCSE ANALYSIS

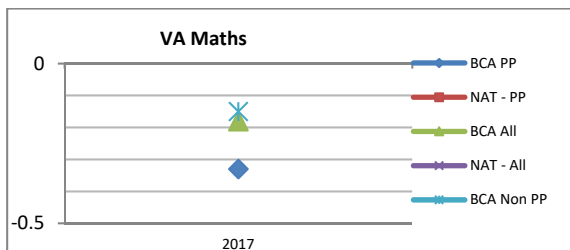
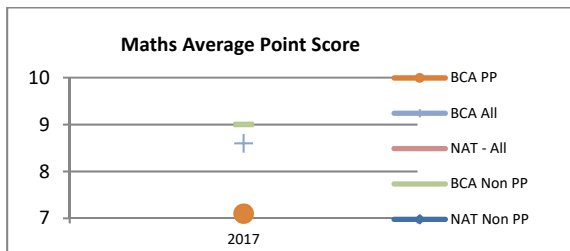
The purpose of the Pupil Premium is to narrow the gap between the attainment and achievement of Pupil Premium students and their non-Pupil Premium peers. The Government's ideal scenario is that the gap between Branston Pupil Premium students and their National non-Pupil Premium is narrowed.

GCSES changed in 2017 and the first set of results are shown below. At present there are no National comparisons available.

English

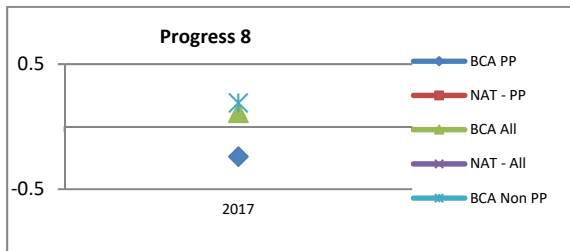


Mathematics



Progress 8 2016

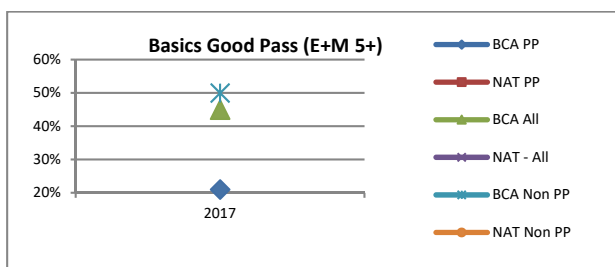
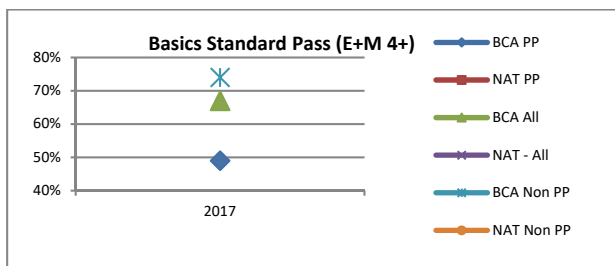
In 2016 the value added measure was changed and re-named Progress 8. The Progress 8 always includes English and Mathematics GCSEs plus 3 courses from the EBACC suite (Science, Geography, History and a Modern Foreign Language) plus 3 other approved courses, which may include vocational courses. This measure is based around 0, where 0 would indicate that a student had achieved their expected grade based on their KS2 results. This is the first year of these measures so comparisons with previous cohorts are not possible.



Attainment Measures

These look at student outcomes without taking any account of the student's ability.

BASICS (English and Mathematics)



English Bacallaureate

This measures the percentage of students that achieve the English Bacallaureate suite of subjects. The subjects included are English, Mathematics, two Sciences, Geography or History and a Modern Foreign Language.
