Mixed Pathway

Three courses that are a mix of the 'traditional' academic and the more vocational/coursework options:

EG:

- **Computing, Maths, Physics**
- **Health and Social Care, History, Psychology**
- **Travel and Tourism, Sociology, French**
- **Sports Studies, Biology, Psychology**
- **Business, English, Performing Arts**
- **Health and Social Care Double, Biology**
- **Sports Studies Double, Psychology**
- **Health and Social Care, BTEC Science, Biology**



Traditional Pathway

Study 3 A Levels

Examples:

- **English, History, Art**
- **Maths, Physics, DT,**
- **Sociology, French, Business Studies**
- *Or any combination**

EG Medicine at Manchester University

Chemistry **or** Biology:

Plus one of the following subjects: Chemistry; Biology;
Physics; Psychology; Mathematics



Specialised Pathway

Know that you have a strong interest/ability in:

- **Health and Social Care**
- **Computing**
- **Business**
- **PE/Sports Studies**
- **Art**

You can study a **two** 'A' level equivalent course in any of these and a third 'A' level or equivalent from the rest of the curriculum.



GCSEs

For those students that do not get a grade 4 or above:

- English
- Maths

Opportunity to resit in November Y12 as well as the summer.

Plus Level 2 Childcare to be studied as a alongside other Level 3 courses.
